



### **Why would you consider purchasing a walker and exerciser**

Regular exercise is essential for the physical and mental well-being of horses. Also an automatic free walker is paramount when rehabilitating injured animals. If you have a paddock you can turn them out, but there is little assurance that they will get the exercise they need. Also, lunging horses or having riders exercise your horses is time consuming and costly, especially if you have a large number of animals. Trainers need a way to simultaneously exercise several horses in a controlled environment.

### ***Moving on from the Old style walker***

The first mechanical horse exerciser were walkers where several horses were tied to rotating unit. However, because the horses were tied to the machine many trainers and vets worried that the unnatural head position would lead to musculoskeletal disorders. Obviously the tie up meant that speed and direction change were of a poor quality. Nowadays it is the accepted method to train horses to go forward, down ward thus strengthening the back and hind quarters. Also trainers need a more versatile piece of equipment.

### ***The equiline exerciser***

The equiline free automatic Trainer was the answer to question of how to create the improvement in conditioning, strengthening and training without constraints. Thus replacing the old style walking machines, hand-walking or ponying. The equiline exerciser is based on about 20 years of experience training horses in Europe. Be it for top level competition horses used in hunter jumping or preparing young horses for top level derby races, or just maintaining your horse at the best level of fitness possible. The free run automation employs all the latest proven features of modern training methods to help exercise and rehabilitate all breeds of horses. ### ***Controlled exercise in a natural a way***

The equiline exerciser allows horses to move freely between a set of gates that travel inside a circular fenced track. The natural movement exercises horses as they would in a paddock, out in the field or on a lunge but at a specified pace chosen by the trainer. The simple to operate controls allow the trainer to vary time and pace of exercise.

### **Safety**

Of course the safety of the horses and trainers is written in capitals, swinging energy absorbing safety gates, slip drives, arms that rotate above head height etc etc are features that have become part and parcel of any walker worth its name. Comfort features such as interfaces for signalling cycle end, and remote stops are also included in the state-of-the-art equiline exerciser.
